Wust Minimum Bid 85</p> <p><i>A lovely unused (with slight viewing use) deck with courts representing four different Dutch dynasties, 1697-1890, issued to honor Queen Wilhelmina. It has a blue flower back, scenic aces and gold corners. The linen-style box is complete but worn.</i></p>			
<p>66 Austen Beauties c1905 USA 52+J Excellent OB2 Hochman SU13 J. I Austen Co. Minimum Bid 245</p> <p><i>A scarce deck with a lovely back featuring a young woman with a floral arrangement in her hair. Austen Beauty cards were actually made by SPCC. Aside from their rarity they are collectible for their beautiful backs and unusual Joker on a black background.</i></p>			
<p>67 National Lithographers Deck 1915 USA 52+J Excellent+ OB3 Hochman Un3 USPC Minimum Bid 50</p> <p><i>A gold-edged deck designed to promote the National Lithographers Society with souvenir type pictures, which include officers of the society, contributors to the field of lithography and the lithographic practices of the time on each card. A special one!</i></p>			
<p>68 Teuila Fortune Telling Cards 1923 45 Excellent OB1- Hochman p.241 USPC Minimum Bid 40</p> <p><i>This 45 card gold-edged fortune-telling deck, originally published in 1899, was issued by USPC in 1923. It has neat FT designs on each card and a 14 page explanatory booklet. The back shows a "South Seas" woman telling fortunes. In original slipcase.</i></p>			
<p>69 Congress Rookwood c1910 USA 52+J NM OB1 Hochman US6g USPC Minimum Bid 75</p> <p><i>One of the wonderful Congress decks, this basically mint deck, with its sparkling gold edges, features a portrait of the famous Sitting Bull on the backs. The box is in great shape and completes this super package.</i></p>			
<p>70 Nippon Beer 1970 Japan 52+J Near Mint PB Nintendo Minimum Bid 10</p> <p><i>The Kings depict happy men with moustaches quaffing beer in this ad deck. Joker is the God of beers - Gambrinus. The diamond suit has been replaced with a suit of red Stars. This deck has never been used and is in its original plastic box.</i></p>
