Includes the original booklet which described the cards. Spectacular!</i></p> <p>Minimum 500</p>			
<p>51 Perfection PCC 32+8 Near Mint None Hochman PU2 Perfection PCC</p> <p>c1890 USA</p> <p><i>Early Perfection Bezique deck of 32 cards plus the eight scoring cards [four twos and four threes with a different back] normally found in Bezique sets. It has shiny gold edges and is one of the early Philadelphia versions. A nice deck.</i></p> <p>Minimum 30</p>			
<p>52 Duke for President 52+2J [x2] MS & Mint OB1 G. B. Trudeau/Starbucks Coffee</p> <p>2000 USA</p> <p><i>Double deck commemorating the fictional running for President of the USA in the year 2000 of Duke, the candidate from the Doonesbury Comics. His announcement came in a special presentation on the Larry King show. Fun deck and very hard to find.</i></p> <p>Minimum 40</p>			
<p>53 Yosemite Souvenir 52+J+XC Near Mint OB1 Hoch. S76 Yosemite Park & Curry Co</p> <p>c1925 USA</p> <p><i>Near mint example of this souvenir deck from one of America's most fabled parks. The back shows a nice scene of Banner Peak in the background behind a calm lake with large spruce trees reflecting in the water. Great scenic cards.</i></p> <p>Minimum 55</p>			
<p>54 Goodall – Chinese Junk 52+J Near Mint OB1– Chas. Goodall & Sons</p> <p>c1918 England</p> <p><i>This narrow named "Chinese Junk" with shiny gold edges has a very colorful back depicting a junk at sea. Spade Ace has indistinct purple stamp on bottom right and box bottom flap is loose. Box is a soft raised material with gold embossing.</i></p> <p>Minimum 20</p>			
<p>55 Beauty Named – Dreaming 52+J+XC Mint OB1– Hoch. RU13 Kalamazoo PCC</p> <p>c1910 USA</p> <p><i>Smart Set 400 with one of their more unusual backs. In fine condition in a 'Beauty' box which we have never seen. Back shows a young lady holding a bouquet by a rose trellis and gazing off into the distance. Grayish green back with plain edges.</i></p> <p>Minimum 30</p>			
<p>56 Vanity Fair Transformation 52+J Near Mint 1/2 OB Hoch. T11 USPC</p> <p>c1896 USA</p> <p><i>Great example of this popular transformation deck with a brown back. This is the gold-edged edition. The only defect is a very slight bend on the side of the Joker which is hardly discernible. Even with only ½ the original box this one is still a bargain.</i></p> <p>Minimum 265</p>
