<p>79 Holland Varnish Co. Ltd. c1920 Canada 52+J Near Mint OB1-</p> <p><i>This narrow gold edged ad deck has a great "Early Bird Catches the Worm" Joker. There is special advertising on the SA and back for this Montreal company. The box has a complete brown 8c Canadian wartime tax stamp on one side.</i></p> <p>USPC</p> <p>Minimum Bid 35</p>			
<p>80 Roulette Playing Cards 1905 USA 54 Excellent+ OB1-</p> <p><i>A gambling game with 15 Layout cards and 39 Wheel cards [1 to 36, 0, 00, Wheel]. The 15 cards are laid out so players can place bets, then a wheel card is turned to determine which bets win. The 39 cards are then shuffled, bets made and another card turned.</i></p> <p>Hochman RU8e Willis W. Russell</p> <p>Minimum Bid 65</p>			
<p>81 Miniature Cards c1920 52+J Near Mint OB3</p> <p><i>Miniature cards [about 1 1/4" x 1 3/4"] on cheap stock and cut irregularly. "Full Pack, British Made" reads the original wrapper. <p>82 Oval Patience Cards c1890 Germany 52 Excellent+ OB1-</p> <p><i>Attractive oval cards by Wust with Swiss scenic aces, these cards are patience size and richly colored. The Swiss costumed courts are representative of various Cantons and are labeled with the Canton name and coat-of-arms. They come in a lovely oval box.</i></p> <p>C. L. <p>83 Management by Cards 1975 Germany 32+XC Near Mint PB</p> <p><i>Cartoon characters on each of the 32 cards are likely workers and management in various company positions. <p>84 Picturesque Canada c1900 Canada 52+J Excellent+ OB3 Hochman SCA23 USPC</p> <p><i>An early hard-to-find Canadian souvenir deck for the Canadian Pacific Railway with type C oval souvenir pictures on all the cards and gold edges.
