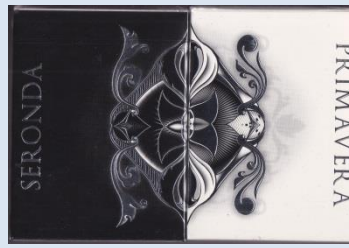

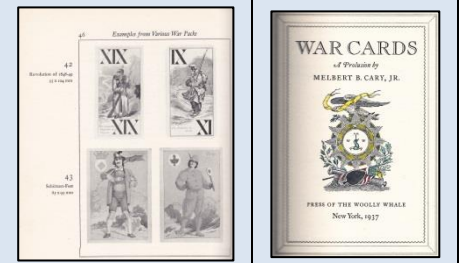

The book was produced in 1937 by Cary's press company - The Press of the Woolly Whale - which also produced the Mademoiselle from Armentieres deck

Each known pack, at the time of writing, produced by a playing card manufacturer, is pictured and described in the book. A necessity for every playing card library. Mr. Field wrote this book in 1987 and it was published by US Games Systems, Inc. In total there are 77 packs described and pictured.
